



School Dental Exam – April 19, 2018

The Regional Office of Education and the Illinois Department of Public Health have teamed up to provide **FREE** dental examinations on **April 19, 2018** for ALL PK -12th grade students in the Franklin School District who return a properly completed permission form. We have attached a form for your convenience.

Additionally, students who qualify for free or reduced lunches or are enrolled in the “All Kids” Program will be offered a cleaning, fluoride treatment, and sealants, if necessary.

This free exam is especially important for students in **kindergarten, second, and sixth** grades who are **required** by the State of Illinois to have an oral health examination prior to **May 15th** of this year.

If your child has not had an examination, we urge you to complete a permission form and return it as soon as possible to take advantage of this program. If you have a student in the required grades and have already taken your child for a dental examination, please provide our school a copy for our files.

Please keep in mind – children in kindergarten, second, and sixth grades are required to have a dental exam. All other students have the option of a free exam.
